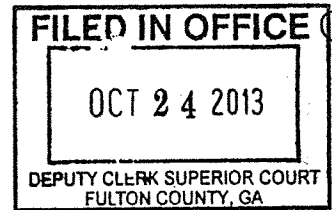

ORDER ON MOTION FOR AN ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

This matter is before the Court on Respondents’ and Plaintiffs-in-Counterclaims’ (the “Beneficiaries”) Motion for an Order to Show Cause and Other Relief. Upon consideration of the motion, the briefs and exhibits submitted therewith, and the record of this case, this Court finds as follows:


The Beneficiaries seek, among other things, an order finding Petitioners and Defendants-in – Counterclaim Bennett L. Kight and William C. Lankford, Jr. (the “Trustees”) in contempt for purportedly failing to produce documents for all accounts relating to the Trusts or entities in which the Trusts have any ownership interest, and a complete schedule of real estate within the time limits set forth in the Court’s Order on Motion for Immediate Interlocutory Injunction (the “Order”). The Beneficiaries also

take issue with the Trustees' use of Trust Assets in May, 2013, to pay legal fees or other costs associated with their defense and ask the Court to reiterate its ruling from prior orders to protect the Trust Assets.

The Court has already addressed the Beneficiaries' concerns in prior orders including the June 10th Order which enjoined the Trustees from transferring or otherwise disposing of Bunzl Trust assets, the August 12th Order which reconsidered the earlier Order and also resolved the request to compel the Trustees to turn over documentation regarding the assets and administration of the Bunzl Trusts, and the September 19th Order which ruled on the Beneficiaries concern regarding the Trustees' production of documents and the obligation to produce to the Beneficiaries any documents provided to the Receiver. Otherwise, any additional points raised in the instant motion have been previously considered by the Court and denied.

The Beneficiaries have failed to point to any alleged conduct by the Trustees that amounts to a violation of the Court's previous Orders. Moreover, the Court assumes the Receiver will alert the Court to any perceived deficiencies in either parties' compliance with the Court's Orders . For these reasons, the motion is **DENIED**.
