ORDER ON PENDING DISCOVERY MOTIONS

The above-styled matter is before the Court on various discovery-related motions, *to wit*:

1) Defendants' Motion for Order Permitting Redaction of CurePoint's Documents; 2)

Defendants' Supplemental Motion for Protective Order and Motion to Quash or Modify Subpoena; 3) Non-party Harvey L. Simpson, III, M.D.'s Motion for Protective Order and to Quash Subpoena; and 4) Non-party CurePoint's Motion for Protective Order and to Modify Subpoena.

All of the foregoing motions center on the desire of Defendants, non-party Simpson, and non-party CurePoint to withhold or redact what the Court finds to be otherwise relevant and discoverable information based on the alleged improper use of same by Plaintiff's brother, an officer, representative, and agent of one or more entities implicated in this and related actions. Having considered the record, the Court finds that this issue is one which should be resolved, and is routinely resolved in such cases, by an appropriate protective/confidentiality order limiting the

persons who may have access to any allegedly-sensitive or confidential information and limiting what those persons may do with that information. Accordingly, the Court orders as follows:

- Counsel for the parties are instructed to confer again on a proposed protective/confidentiality order and report back to the Court within five (5) days of the entry of this order with a joint proposed order.
- If the parties are unable to agree on a protective/confidentiality order, each side may present their proposed order to the Court no later than 5:00pm on Thursday, December 20, 2018.
