FOURTH AMENDED CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER

This matter comes before the Court after reviewing correspondence submitted by the parties on June 26, 2023. The parties requested that the Court amend its Third Amended Case Management Order, entered March 20, 2023. Upon review and consideration of the correspondence, the Court grants the requested extensions as set forth below. However, the Court takes this opportunity to once again caution counsel that, at the outset, it granted their request for an extensive discovery period and, accordingly, all future requests for extensions will continue to be carefully scrutinized.

The Court ORDERS that the following deadlines for the corresponding activities govern in this case and supersede any conflicting deadlines for such activities contained within the Third Amended Case Management Order:

- The period for expert discovery, which commenced on April 13, 2023, shall expire on July 28, 2023, except that the deposition of Bradford Bright may be completed by August 1, 2023.
- All dispositive motions, including motions for summary judgment, shall be filed on or before 5:00 p.m. on September 29, 2023.
- The parties shall file Daubert motions on or before 5:00 p.m. on
 September 29, 2023.

Except as expressly stated in this Order, the Third Amended Case Management Order, and the deadlines, policies, and procedures listed therein, shall remain in full force and effect and govern this case.
