NOTE ON ABBREVIATIONS

The following abbreviations, taken from those used by the General Assembly, are used in each *Peach Sheet* when reference is made to a particular version of a bill:

<u>Term</u>	<u>Abbreviation</u>
House	H
Senate	S
Bill	B
Resolution	R
Committee Substitute	CS
Committee Amendment	CA
Floor Substitute	FS
Floor Amendment	FA
Rules Committee Substitute	RCS
Conference Committee Substitute	CCS
Conference Committee Amendment	CCA

In many instances, these terms are combined when describing a particular version of a bill. Thus, a substitute version of a bill that was offered by a House committee might be abbreviated as “HCS,” while the version of the same bill that was further amended on the floor of the House might be abbreviated as “HCSFA.”
